Saturday - Phil Downer, will present a life-changing conference for men, focused on biblical principles of discipleship. Phil will cover topics such as purity in marriage, healing brokenness, forgiving past sins, seeing your marriage as your mission for intimacy and excellence, building deep relationships of influence and character building in your children and overcoming stumbling blocks to discipling others outside the family.

Phil serves as President of Discipleship Network of America (DNA), a nationwide network of people committed to following Christ's life of winning and discipling others to become disciple makers. Phil is a popular speaker at men's events, including Promise Keepers, at couples events with his wife, Susy, and at family conferences with his six children. He has appeared on Focus on the Family and his Discipleship Moments daily radio program airs on Truth Talk in 15 cities and 7 states. Phil served as president of CBMC for ten years, is on the Steering Committee of the National Coalition of Men's Ministries, and is a past elder of his church. Phil has authored numerous books including the companion book to this conference, *Eternal Impact, Investing in the Lives of Others*.

David is the Founder and CEO of the National Character Education Foundation, known for recognizing, educating, and promoting the benefits of good character to students, parents, and communities. Prior to founding the NCEF in February 2003, David was a former international baseball player as well as a talent scout for the former Montreal Expos and the Florida Marlins. He is also a Major League baseball analyst for the internationally syndicated Sports show, Sportsweek. David has been a national speaker for over fifteen years and is a featured speaker for the NCEF parental symposiums, which are designed to support and help educators and parents better understand today's ever changing youth culture and its potential dangers to our children and teens.

And has been in the Church of God Reformation Movement since July 1976 and ordained in 1980.
